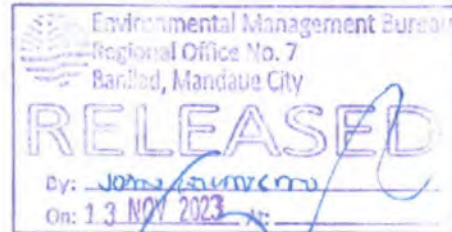

ANNEX A

A. PINTAKALIKASAN (POSTER MAKING CONTEST)

Mechanics:

1. The participants will be given two (2) hours only to finish their work.
2. Each participant should submit one (1) entry only.
3. The poster must illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the theme of the “Circular Actions for Climate hope.”
4. The following materials will be used in the contest:
 - a. $\frac{1}{2}$ illustration board (white background, to be provided by the contestants)
 - b. Mongol Pencil (to be provided by the contestants)
 - c. Coloring Materials: oil pastel/cray-pas, markers, ink, oil acrylic, and watercolor (to be provided by the contestants)
 - d. Pentel Pen (to be provided by the contestants)

*Bringing other necessary materials are allowed such as erasers, sharpeners, rulers, etc.

5. The contestants should be at the place of the competition fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled time. Time and place will be announced prior to the start of the contest during the morning program.
6. Late contestants are still allowed to participate; however, they will be deprived of the minutes they missed.
7. Posters must be done through free hand.
8. The artist will be held accountable for any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.
9. Winners will receive prizes and giveaways.
10. All entries will be used by the Environmental Management Bureau VII for advocacy materials and activities.
11. Criteria for judging:
 - a. Creativity and presentation (20%)
 - b. Relevance to the theme (40%)
 - c. Originality (30%)
 - d. Overall Impact (10%)

B. BALAK PARA SA KALIKUPAN (SPOKEN POETRY)

Mechanics:

1. The spoken poetry must be an original composition. It should be written in Filipino, English, or Cebuano dialect (use of Taglish is not allowed).
2. The entry must illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the theme “Circular Action for Climate Hope,” and must not contain any malicious or offensive content.
3. The overall poem must not exceed three (3) minutes.
4. Sounds, instrumental or musical background is allowed to complement the delivery. No deduction shall be made if the contestant chooses not to have a musical background.
5. Winners will receive prizes and giveaways.



6. Criteria for judging

- i. Message/Content (40%)
 - o The content of the spoken poetry illustrates, interprets, and emphasizes the theme.
 - o The piece has a powerful and meaningful message to the audience.
- ii. Delivery and Performance (30%)
 - o The spoken piece is delivered as to what emotion is asked in the piece.
 - o Connection to the audience was established from the start.
 - o Facial expression, hand and body gestures emphasized the different elements of the performance.
 - o Eye contact pulled the audience to the message of the spoken words.
 - o The audience's attention and interest were captured and sustained throughout the delivery.
 - o Pronunciation and enunciation sound natural and clear. The audience can understand what is being spoken.
 - o Words are pronounced distinctly and correctly. Does not stutter nor stammer.
 - o The music or background music must complement the piece. The volume of the background music or instrument must not cover the voice of the presenter.
- iii. Originality (20%)
 - o The piece must be an original composition of the contestant.
- iv. Overall Impact-10%
 - o The contestant must evoke emotions from the viewers and must engage them from the onset to the end without losing momentum.

C. SANGKA SA KAALAM PARA SA KALIKUPAN (QUIZ BEE)

Mechanics:

I. General Rules

- a. The contestants should be at the place of the competition fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled time. Time and place will be announced prior to the start of the contest during the morning program.
- b. Late contestants are still allowed to participate; however, they will be deprived to answer the question(s) they missed. But after the first five (5) questions have lapsed, late contestants will be disqualified.
- c. Clarifications regarding the rules of the competition shall be entertained by the committee before the start of the contest.
- d. The questions will be based on the mandates of the Environmental Bureau Management (EMB), climate change or other related to environment. Additional information will be taken from the news in print or in the media.

II. Quiz Bee Proper

- a. Cellular or mobile phones are not allowed during the contest proper.
- b. The teams will write their answers on the board provided by the committee using markers.
- c. The type of questions will be multiple choice and identification.
- d. Questions will have a time limit of **10 seconds** for an easy round, 15 seconds for an average round and **20 seconds** for a difficult round. A tie breaker will be held once there are two or more participating team that have the same scores.



- c. Each question will be read twice. After the second reading, the quizmaster shall say “go,” only then the groups will be allowed to write their answers. Automatically, the time limit begins with the word “go” of the quizmaster.
- f. After the time limit, a buzzer sound will be heard which signals that the contestants must stop writing and must raise their boards immediately. Failure to do so will signal a warning for the first offense and disqualification for the second.
- g. The quizmaster shall read and verify the participants’ answers.
- h. Any question or query to the correctness of the answers should be raised before the start of the next question.
- i. The team who gets the highest number of points will automatically be declared as champion and runners-up respectively.
