- This Office, through the Policy, Planning, and Research Division (PPRD) in collaboration with the Regional Research Committee (RRC) hereby disseminates the Summary of Assessed Action Research Proposals under the Basic Education Research Fund (BERF) 2023 Facility Program of DepEd Region VII-Central Visayas.
- These proposals were respectively submitted by the 20 Schools Division Offices (SDOs)
 as counterparts of DepEd Region VII after the conduct of the call for proposals as spearheaded
 by the Regional Research Committee in support of the Department's Policy Research Program.
- 3. Furthermore, the said proposals have undergone the initial screening as then managed by the respective Secretariats and have therefore complied all the eligibility requirements pursuant to DepEd Order No. 16, s.2017, "Research Management Guidelines".
- 4. After the initial screening, the proponents were informed of the results by the Secretariat. Likewise, proposals that passed the process have been endorsed for rigorous committee evaluation using the criteria and scoring template prescribed in the above stated guidelines.
- In addition, pre-oral presentations were organized where the proponents were provided with technical inputs for consideration prior to the research implementation under DepEd RO VII's Project CAREs (Committed to Assist Research Enthusiasts).
- 6. Thus, after the administration of the call and evaluation of proposals, the research proponents are then encouraged to incorporate the given suggestions, comments, and recommendations by the research committee in order to finally qualify for approval. Also, they are directed to submit copies of finalized action research proposals and/or enhanced work plans and other necessary deliverables for the release of the BERF's first tranche as part of the research grant.
