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

The DepEd Learner Rights and Protection Office is mandated to lead in the planning, implementing, coordinating, monitoring and evaluation of programs, projects, and activities related to learner rights and protection in schools and at all governance levels of the Department, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2021<sup>1</sup>.

Correspondingly, under DO No. 003, the Education Support Services Division at the Regional Level,<sup>2</sup> the Schools Governance and Operations Division at the Schools Division Office Level,<sup>3</sup> and the Child Protection Committees (CPCs) at the School Level<sup>4</sup> are the coordinating arms of the LRPO for the planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation, reporting, and coordination of learner rights and protection concerns.

Further, in accordance with DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012, or the "DepEd Child Protection Policy," **all public and private elementary and secondary schools shall establish a Child Protection Committee,**<sup>5</sup> which shall be composed of the following, viz:

1. School Head/Administrator- Chairperson;
2. Guidance Counselor/Teacher- Vice Chairperson;
3. Representative of the Teachers as designated by the Faculty Club;
4. Representative of the Parents as designated by the Parents-Teachers Association;
5. Representative of pupils, students and learners as designated by the Supreme Student Council; and
6. Representative from the Community as designated by the *Punong Barangay*, preferably a member of the *Barangay Council* for the Protection of Children (BCPC).

Furthermore, LRPO has a separate unit, the Child Protection Committee (CPC) Functionality Support Unit, that takes charge of the assessment of the functionality of child protection committees (CPCs), learner rights and protection concern data, and monitoring and evaluation of CPCs.

In view of the foregoing, may we request **the list of the focal persons for the members of the Child Protection Committees in Schools and the accomplishment of the CPC Profiling Form (Enclosure 1)** through the Google link: <https://tinyurl.com/2023CPCProfilingForm> or through the QR code below. The given link must be filled out by the Chairperson or Vice Chairperson to avoid duplicate entries in similar school.

The requested information will be utilized by the LRPO for the reinforcement of DO 40 s. 2012 in relation to the mandatory establishment of the functional CPCs in schools, as well as for the development of a monitoring tool to determine the functionality of the said CPCs. Please see the **Data Submission Update (Enclosure 2)** for the summary of 2022 CPC Training Needs Survey.
