This has reference to the correspondence from the Office of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Teaching dated April 13, 2023 requesting for the commitment of the Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents, and School Heads in putting up or maintaining an infrastructure that makes reading materials available for all learners to support the Department's thrusts in improving quality basic education.

Relative to the said request, this is to reiterate further to maintain the established Learning Resource (LR) facility in the Regional Offices (ROs), Schools Division Offices (SDOs), and schools as it serves multipurpose functions on various LR processes and activities.

Hence it is recommended to have the said facility be improved and organized for efficient delivery of the regional and division libraries' information services and serve as venues for collaboration, meetings, workshop preparation, and a temporary hub for learning resources to be distributed to schools. In the schools, the library/ learning resource center facility is expected to cater to the day-to-day academic needs of the learners and teachers.

We anticipate a positive response and continuous support of the Department's priority activities.
