**CONDUCT OF THE NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP (NLC)**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) is set to roll out the National Learning Camp (NLC) during the 2022-2023 End-of-School Year (EOSY) break.
2. The NLC aims to improve learning outcomes and support teachers to teach better. The program will start on July 24, 2023 and end on August 25, 2023.
3. It is emphasized that the NLC is a voluntary program on the part of the teachers since it entails services of teachers beyond regular school days. Those teachers that will be participating will be given service credits, certificate of recognition, and other incentives, subject to the guidelines that has been set for the purpose and availability of funds.
4. Relative thereto, the Schools Division Superintendents are hereby advised to remind Schools Heads and Other Officials in their area of jurisdiction not to force teachers to participate in the NLC since guidelines provides that NLC is purely voluntary.
5. Strict monitoring will be implemented relative to the conduct of NLC implementation.
6. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
