We are pleased to inform you that the new mobile science facility of the Department of Science and Technology Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) dubbed as “nuLab” will make its first appearance in Dumaguete City as part of the Science for the Youth activity of the **2023 National Science and Technology Week** on **September 20-23, 2023**. (Please refer to the attached program and schedule of nuLab sessions)

nuLab is a bus designed to enable senior high school students to discover their potentials in the various disciplines in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM), and eventually consider careers along these lines. It is equipped with audio-visual and educational tools and equipment useful in introducing concepts and developing skills among the students relevant to building the future human resource of an Industrial Revolution 4.0 – ready Philippines. The facility also includes a strategic campaign called “*Push4Science: Maging DOST Scholar Ka!*” at the end of every session, to persuade the student-participants to apply to the DOST-SEI undergraduate scholarship programs and entice them to choose STEM as a field of study and career.

The nuLab sessions will be conducted for four days from September 20-23, 2023. There will be two (2) sessions per day, at four (4) hours per session (8:00 AM to 12:00 PM; 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM). Each session will accommodate a maximum of twenty-four (24) students and two (2) DepEd personnel (as guardian and observers).

In line with this, we would like to seek your assistance in identify the participating students from public senior high schools in your division. There should be twenty-four (24) Grade 11 students from STEM strand with equal proportion of male and female accompanied by two (2) guardians/observers. Please also consider those students who are members of IP or GIDCA communities, if any. Each batch per division may all come from one (1) school or several schools.

Your division's schedule for the nuLab session is on **September 22, 2023 (Friday)** from **1:00 PM to 5:00 PM**, at the Robinsons Mall (main entrance area), Dumaguete City.
