THE 1st AMA BRAINS OLYMPIAD General Mechanics and Guidelines

I. SCHEDULE AND VENUE

- A. The AMA Brains Olympiad will consist of eliminations (National Eliminations, Quarter Finals, Semi-Finals) and the National Finals. The National Eliminations and Quarter Finals will be conducted via live streaming or online platforms such as Zoom Meetings at the nearest AMAES campus. The Semi-Finals will be held in Metro Manila. Participating schools outside Metro and Mega Manila shall join via live streaming or online platforms such as Zoom Meetings. The National Finals will be held in Metro Manila.
- B. Transportation of the national finalists, including the coach and substitute shall be shouldered by AMAES.
- C. AMAES shall shoulder the accommodation expenses of the national finalists, including the coach and substitute, from outside Metro and Mega Manila only.
- D. Elimination Dates:
 - National Eliminations: 9 November 2023
 - Quarter Finals: 24 November 2023
 - Semi-Finals: 7 December 2023
 - National Finals: 12 January 2024

II. GENERAL PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

A. Schools and Contestants

1. Each participating public or private school shall be eligible to field one (1) team only.
2. The contestants are the official school representatives to participate in the event. The contestants must be bona fide students from the Grade 11 to Grade 12 of a public or private school.

3. Each team must be composed of three (3) members (excluding the substitute):
 - One (1) Grade 11 student;
 - Two (2) Grade 12 students;
 - The substitute may come from the Grade 11 or Grade 12 level.

B. Coverage

The questions shall be classified into the following fields:

- Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Earth Science)
- Mathematics (Algebra, Geometry, Trigonometry, Statistics, and Pre-Calculus)
- General Information and Current Events
- English (Language Proficiency, Philippine Literature, World Literature)
- Philippine History
- World History
- Information Technology and Computer Science

C. Registration

Schools may register before the event through the Admission Office of the nearest AMAES campus.

D. Prizes

An exciting array of prizes await the National Finals winners!

- Grand Champion - P30,000 (plus trophy and medals)
- 1st Runner-up - P15,000 (plus trophy and medals)
- 2nd Runner-up - P10,000 (plus trophy and medals)
- 3rd Runner-up - P5,000 (plus trophy and medals)
- 4th Runner-up - P3,000 (plus trophy and medals)

Members of the top three winning schools will also receive college tuition fee discount at any AMAES campus in the Philippines.
