



Rationale: Preschool classrooms often have a wide range of students with different abilities, learning styles, and developmental needs. Differentiated instruction helps teachers adapt their teaching methods to meet each child's unique learning requirements, promoting better student engagement, understanding, and progress.

This 2-day workshop provides a focused introduction to differentiated instruction in the preschool classroom and emphasizes practical application through hands-on activities and group discussions.
