Regional ALS Focal Persons are advised to facilitate the most convenient means on the reimbursement of expenses of the participants for this activity. **Downloading of funds to the respective schools divisions of the participants is highly encouraged**, when deemed necessary and applicable.

In case that the downloaded funds are not sufficient to cover the actual expenses incurred, **Program Support Fund (PSF) CY 2022 or local funds** will be utilized to augment the reimbursement of the said expenses.
