DATE : July 10, 2023

The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) serves as the focal office for the implementation of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) program in the Department of Education (DepEd). As mandated by DepEd Order No. 47 s. 2021, titled Creation of the Bureau of Alternative Education in the Department of Education, one of BAE's functions is to lead the development and management of ALS K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) related activities, in coordination with the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD).

Consistent with the Department of Education's MATATAG Agenda which focuses on making the curriculum relevant to produce competent and job ready, active and responsible citizens, the formal education K to 10 Curriculum was revised. Part of the policy action is to align the curriculum of both formal and non-formal education targeting competencies to prepare learners for life, work, and sustainable development.

Being a parallel learning system provides a viable alternative to formal education instruction, it is important that the ALS K to 10 BEC remain relevant and aligned with the formal Curriculum (Revised K to 10 Curriculum).

In this connection, the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) in coordination with BCD will conduct the **Writershop on the Review and Alignment of Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Curriculum vis-a-vis the Revised K to 10 Curriculum** from July 17 to 21, 2023 in City State Asturias Hotel, South National Highway, Tinguiban Heights, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan.

This activity aims to:
