CAPABILITY BUILDING AND ESTABLISHMENT OF SCHOOL DCP REPAIR HUB




- 1. DepEd recognizes the importance of technology in education thus the implementation of the DepEd Computerization Program (DCP). However, the impact of the DCP implementation is challenged by the failure of sustaining its use in the teaching and learning process and governance. One of the reasons for this is the lack of personnel that can fix the equipment and/or limited resources to fund the repair or replacement of broken parts.
- 2. In 2011, DepEd released an order, DepEd Order No. 36 s. 2011, providing guidance on the repair and maintenance of computer units that are out of warranty. This policy directed all high schools with non-working computers to communicate with Tech-Voc Schools to provide repair and maintenance of said DepEd equipment. There were ninety-nine (99) Tech-Voc schools across the country identified in the said order. Out of the 99, nine (9) are from Region VII (1 from Bohol, none from Negros Oriental, 7 from Cebu Island and 1 from Siquijor).
- 3. Considering the number of defective computers needing repair in Region VII (3,933 units based on DCP Inventory System) and the location of the schools with defective units, these 9 schools cannot fully serve the schools that are needing assistance. Also, with the diverse technical specifications, these identified schools were no longer able to keep up with the skills needed to repair the DCP equipment. In addition to this, there is no Computer Technician plantilla in the Division Office nor in the schools that may provide repair and maintenance services.
- 4. Hence, the Information and Communications Technology Unit of the DepEd Regional Office organizes a series of capability building for selected teacher/s from select secondary schools offering Computer Software Servicing (CSS) in their Senior High School (SHS) curriculum.
- 5. This undertaking aims to:
 - a. establish a DCP School Repair Hub that will cater to the repair needs of schools within their SDO or district and













- b. provide SHS learners actual experience in doing the repair and maintenance of computers after they are trained by the teacher participants as part of their requirement in the CSS course.
- 6. The Schools Division Offices are therefore requested to provide their recommended schools that will become a DCP Repair Hub on or before October 13, 2023. Here is the initial list as agreed during the 1st Semester 2023 ITO Convergence cum Project Implementation Review.
