





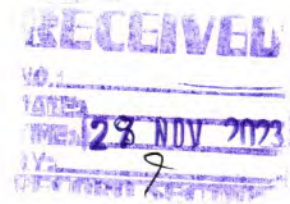
SUBJECT : **CANCELLATION OF SU LIBRO (BOOK DONATION)**
