

The Department of Science and Technology - Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (DOST-PHIVOLCS) is glad to inform you of its annual capacity development project for the Department of Education (DepEd). The project, titled "TEACH VETDRR - Training Educators and Administrators for a Collective Headway towards Volcano, Earthquake, and Tsunami Disaster Risk Reduction," aims to capacitate DepEd teaching and non-teaching staff towards geologic disaster awareness and preparedness. The project is proposed and programmed every year, with established target areas.

For 2023, we are inviting one (1) participant from each Schools Division Office (SDO) in Visayas for the "Training on Communicating Volcano, Earthquake, and Tsunami Hazards for Education Program Specialists/Supervisors for Science." The activity aims to train selected Division EPS on the science of volcanic eruption, earthquake, and tsunami; how to mitigate their impacts; how to access DOST-PHIVOLCS information materials, tools, and innovations; and how to communicate this information to students.

The training is proposed to be done on April 18 to 20, 2023 in a face-to-face mode. We encourage equal number of women and men participants and each participant is expected to attend the whole duration of the activity. We will provide the full board accommodation for 3 days and 2 nights and the training materials. No registration fee will be collected. Finally, the training will be conducted within Cebu Province.

Hence, would like to invite your office to be the "host regional office" for the activity, the role of which includes provision of logistical or administrative support if needed. We would also like to invite you or your nominated point person to attend a pre-training meeting via video teleconferencing (VTC) with DepEd Regions VI and VIII on March 6, 2023.
