



LANGUAGE MAPPING AND PROFICIENCY TESTING

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. In support to the MATATAG Agenda to review the implementation of the mother tongue-based education, a Language Mapping and Proficiency Testing will be conducted in Region VII. A team of language experts was organized by USAID RTI ABC+ project to conduct the activity starting July 17, 2023.
2. The language mapping and or proficiency testing activities will be undertaken to determine the appropriate instructional approaches and strategies in improving learning outcomes as well as in designing developmentally-appropriate literacy materials for K to 3 learners in the region. Likewise, this intends to:
 - a. identify the major languages in the region that may be used for foundational learning of K to 3 learners; and
 - b. identify the proficiency of K to 3 learners in Filipino, English, and languages other than their first language.
3. The team of language experts who will take care of the language mapping/proficiency testing is composed of the following:
 - Ricardo Ma. D. Nolasco – chief linguist, retired professor, UP Department of Linguistics
 - Antonio B. Igalinos – public policy specialist
 - Janus Cabazares – linguist, assistant professor, UP Mindanao
 - Ryan Dennis Callueng – linguist, director, PNU Language Studies Center
 - Maia Binhi Borja – sociology graduate, writer, editor
4. In this regard, this Office requests your assistance in facilitating the conduct of the said activities by:
 - identifying a sample section (1 section for Kinder, and 1 section for Grade 3) from each of the selected 5 schools (see attached list of sample schools) in your division;

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- making available in the identified schools during their schedule of assessment, the following:
 - School heads and the assigned PSDSs of the school
 - 2 assessors per school (1 grade one assessor and 1 grade three assessor)
 - 10 randomly selected Kindergarten (5 boys and 5 girls) and 10 randomly selected Grade 3 learners (5 boys and 5 girls) from the identified sample section (a total of 20 sample learners per school)
 - Teacher-adviser of the sampled sections
 - providing a venue for assessment;
 - ensuring that all the identified assessors (10) in the division will attend the orientation on July 14, 2023 at 1:00 in the afternoon; and
 - informing the parents of the sampled learners and **securing their consent for the participation of their children prior to the scheduled asesment.**
